HUNTERSVILLE, NC:

On June 14th, 2020 at approximately 4:44 PM, officers with the Huntersville Police Department responded to a single vehicle accident with injuries on the I-77 South exit ramp to I-485 Outer. Upon their arrival at the scene, it was determined that one of the occupants of the vehicle had been shot during an apparent road rage incident that occurred on I-77 within the jurisdiction of Huntersville. The driver was transported to the hospital with serious injuries.

The victims described the suspect as a light skin black male, around 19-22 years of age, thin build, tattoo (possibly on the right side of the neck) and short dreads. The suspect was possibly operating the below pictured Kia Optima displaying a fictitious temporary South Carolina license plate (also pictured below).
